

IAMRA Membership Committee Charge

The Management Committee formally established the IAMRA Membership Committee on January 31, 2007. The Membership Committee operates under the following charge.

The IAMRA Membership Committee shall:

- Continue to build membership, particularly in currently under-represented jurisdictions, and assist the Management Committee to develop regional membership targets – supporting IAMRA to reach its goal of 100 members by the end of 2016.
- Define, develop and articulate the IAMRA membership offer - ensuring that it brings value to members and that it meets their varying needs and requirements - and bring proposals to the Management Committee for consideration by the end of 2015.
- Build institutional knowledge through a survey of the membership (to be completed by the end of 2015), to cover the following issues:
 - The value that Members expect to get from their IAMRA membership
 - The top three key policy or business regulatory issues they're facing as regulators in their own countries
 - What CPD/CME/revalidation processes members have in place
 - What accreditation standards/processes members have in place for accrediting medical schools/programmes
 - The running of the General Assembly and members opportunities to participate
 - General information (e.g. number of doctors registered; Fitness to Practice processes; regulatory functions they are responsible for etc.)
- Review IAMRA membership categories and dues structure (including consideration of a permanent fee decrease for Members of National and Multi-National Associations) and bring proposals to the Management Committee by the end of 2015.
- Make recommendations for the running of the Members General Assembly and bring proposals to the Management Committee by the end of 2015.
