

### **IAMRA Continued Competency Working Group Charge**

The Continued Competency Working Group reports to the Management Committee and operates under the following charge.

- 1.** The Continued Competency Working Group will assist the Management Committee to achieve IAMRA's Goals\* as set by the Management Committee from time to time.
- 2.** The Continued Competency Working Group's work program will include, but not be limited to objectives related to assurance of continued competence of physicians as set by the Management Committee from time to time. Currently, these objectives are as follows:
  - Encourage members to provide updated information regarding their continued competency policies/programs
  - Create a list of links to members' continued competency policies/programs
  - Develop additional resources for use by members, relating to the promotion of best practice in assuring the ongoing competence of registrants/licenseses.
- 3.** The Continued Competency Working Group will support program planning for IAMRA's Continued Competency Symposia.
- 4.** The Continued Competency Working Group will advise the Management Committee on any other matters it considers to be relevant to the pursuit of IAMRA's Vision, Goals and Objectives.
- 5.** The Continued Competency Working Group will provide regular reports to the Management Committee and a report to the Members General Assembly.

\*IAMRA's current Goals, are as follows:

1. Creating a global community of medical regulators by expanding IAMRA's membership and influence;
2. Promoting appropriate accreditation processes to achieve high standards in medical education and training;
3. Supporting and encouraging members to develop mechanisms for assuring the continued competence of doctors;
4. Promoting and enabling the proactive sharing of fitness to practice/disciplinary information among IAMRA members;
5. Strengthening the evidence base for regulation by encouraging research and evaluation of regulatory processes, and the publication and sharing of findings.
