



## **IAMRA Membership Committee Charge**

The Membership Committee reports to the Management Committee and operates under the following charge.

1. The Membership Committee will to assist the Management Committee to achieve IAMRA's Goals\* as set by the Management Committee from time to time.
2. The Membership Committee's work program will include, but not be limited to the membership-related Objectives set by the Management Committee from time to time. Currently, these objectives are as follows:
  - Increase membership in underrepresented areas (e.g., Central and South America, Europe, non-English-speaking Africa)
  - Identify key IAMRA resources that will be offered in other languages (website, conference)
  - Facilitating opportunities for interaction among IAMRA members (e.g., webinar, conferences and symposia, social media)
  - Draft statements:
    - a. Primacy of patient safety
    - b. Supporting the independence of regulation
  - Review format, frequency and content of membership survey
3. The Membership Committee will also advise the Management Committee on any other matters it considers to be relevant to the pursuit of IAMRA's Vision, Goals and Objectives.
4. The Membership Committee will provide regular reports to the Management Committee and a report to the Members General Assembly.

\*IAMRA's current Goals, are as follows:

1. Creating a global community of medical regulators by expanding IAMRA's membership and influence;
2. Promoting appropriate accreditation processes to achieve high standards in medical education and training;
3. Supporting and encouraging members to develop mechanisms for assuring the continued competence of doctors;
4. Promoting and enabling the proactive sharing of fitness to practice/disciplinary information among IAMRA members;
5. Strengthening the evidence base for regulation by encouraging research and evaluation of regulatory processes, and the publication and sharing of findings.
